

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion at Mass

Our Mission:

Extraordinary ministers assist in the distribution of holy Communion. This is a wonderful opportunity to share the body and blood of Christ with your fellow parishioners.

Requirements:

To serve in this ministry, you must have received the sacrament of confirmation. An exception is made to allow high school students to serve as Communion ministers at the 6:00 p.m. Sunday Mass.

Training/Formation:

All Adult Volunteers

Extraordinary ministers of holy Communion are asked to attend 1-2 formation sessions each year.

- ◆ Requirements can be met by attending formation sessions presented by our parish.
- ◆ Training sessions for extraordinary ministers of holy Communion qualify as formation sessions.
- ◆ Formation activities near the end of one year can be counted toward either that year or the next.

Time Commitment:

We ask for a commitment of at least one weekend Mass per month, and scheduling can be flexible for those who travel seasonally.
