

# Mass Servers

## **Our Mission:**

Assisting the priest at the altar is a wonderful way to participate in the celebration of Mass. Our servers light candles, join in procession, hold the Roman Missal (formerly called the sacramentary book) for the priest, greet people with the sign of peace, and give other help that is needed.

## **Who Can Join:**

All youth in our parish, grade four and above, are invited to become Mass servers. They must have received first Eucharist. There is no upper age limit for servers. They may continue into adulthood.

## **Skills Needed:**

- ❖ Ability to follow directions
- ❖ Eagerness to actively participate in Mass
- ❖ Ability to perform duties listed in the above mission
- ❖ Willingness to find substitute if not able to serve at scheduled Mass time

## **Training:**

- ❖ One class presented by priest
- ❖ New servers are paired up with experienced servers during first few times

## **Time Commitment:**

Varies based on number of servers volunteering for a specific Mass time. Usually servers are scheduled once every 4-6 weeks.
