

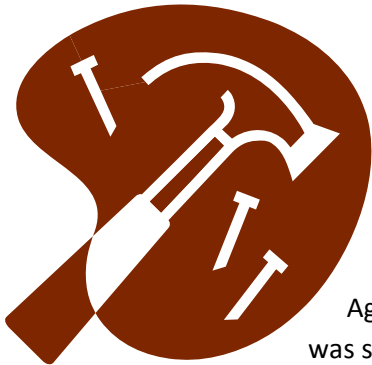

ST. FRANCIS BORGIA WORKCAMP CODE OF CONDUCT

As a participant in the St. Francis Borgia Workcamp Program, I agree to the Group Mission Trips Code of Conduct. Additionally, I agree to the following specific items set forth by St. Francis Borgia Parish:

- 1.) Personal music devices may be used during sleep/rest time only (not at your worksite, not during any programmed activity, and minimally during any free time). If this privilege is abused, the device will be confiscated until after the trip.
- 2.) Cell phones may be used, minimally, during free time only (not at your worksite, not on the bus, not after lights out, and not during any programmed activity). Then, they are to be used for calling home, not visiting with friends. THIS ALSO APPLIES TO TEXTING! If this privilege is abused, the phone will be confiscated.
- 3.) Male and female sleeping areas at camp and en route to/from camp are to be respected.
- 4.) School property (including phones, computers, or other equipment) such as found in our sleeping rooms, hallways, locker rooms, etc. are not for our personal use and as such are off limits. If you have a question about whether you can use something, ask an adult!
- 5.) No pets/stray animals will be allowed to, from or at Workcamp.
- 6.) **GIRLS: ONLY SHIRTS WITH SLEEVES ARE ALLOWED ON WORKSITES...PERIOD.**
NO spaghetti strap, strapless, low cut, bare back, halter, offensive logo, holes, or bare midriff tops will be permitted. Tank tops are allowed at base camp only! **One-piece bathing suits** must be worn during any public swim times (bikini or strapless suits may *only* be worn in the showers). NO short shorts, or low rider shorts/pants, or pants/shorts with holes in the crotch or butt areas will be allowed. Females are expected to wear a bra, and sports bras or swimsuit tops are not to be worn without a covering shirt. Pajamas are to be worn only for bed, not as regular clothing. Full clothing, not towels, are to be worn to and from the shower areas. Appropriate shoes must always be worn.

GUYS: ONLY SHIRTS WITH SLEEVES ARE ALLOWED ON WORKSITES...PERIOD. Shirts are to be worn at all times, including on hot days and to and from the shower areas. NO cut off t-shirts will be permitted. Appropriate swim trunks must be worn during public swim times. Additionally, full clothing, not towels, are to be worn to and from the shower areas. No low rider pants/shorts, or pants/shorts with holes in the crotch or butt areas will be allowed. T-shirts with holes or offensive logos are not permitted. Pajamas are to be worn only for bed, not as regular clothing. Appropriate shoes must always be worn.

We represent St. Francis Borgia Parish wherever we go. Our behaviors and attitudes speak volumes about who we are. Let us be proud of the way our group lives their faith.

I have read and understand this Code of Conduct. I understand that if I violate this code of conduct, I may be sent home by parish adult leadership, or by the workcamp staff. It is out of respect for God, myself and others that I abide by these rules, and those set forth by Group Mission Trips.
