A Tremendous Opportunity

The pastor and leaders of St. Paul the Apostle Parish in Mukono, Uganda have identified as their number one priority their need for a Catholic primary school. While there are Catholic schools in some of the outback sub-parishes, there is no Catholic school in the city of Mukono. Catechism is taught outdoors in the shade.

They have asked for our help.

The nine pilgrims from St. Francis Borgia who recently visited Uganda can tell you that the request for a new school is not extravagant: simple rooms with brick walls, a cement floor and a tin roof. The cost to construct a two-classroom block is 18 million Ugandan schillings ...or just \$10,000. The cost to construct an entire 10 classroom school would be \$50,000.

Our Response

On September 18, 2006, the St. Francis Borgia Parish Council approved the proposal that one percent (1%) of the contributions to our Building Fund Appeal over the next five years be earmarked for the Mukono school project. It is important for you to know that 1% of your generosity towards the Building Fund will be used in this way. In conversations with parishioners, the response to this proposal has been overwhelmingly positive. If it is your desire to specify how your own contributions to the Building Fund Appeal should, or should not, be utilized for a new school in Mukono, simply write your intentions anywhere on the Building Fund Commitment card. We will honor your intentions.
