Lectors (Adult and High School)

Our Mission:

We proclaim the Scriptures at our weekend, weekday, and holy day liturgies.

Requirements:

Those participating in the lector ministry should be motivated by spiritual reasons: desire to proclaim the Word of God so that people listen and understand. They must be willing to devote preparation time before each assignment. Adults and high school youth are welcome.

Skills Needed:

Helpful skills include public speaking ability (enunciation, projection, expression) and a willingness to respond to suggestions for improvement.

Adult Training and Formation:

New Adult Lectors:

- ❖ Orientation session
- ❖ Two or more individual mentoring sessions

Time Commitment:

Preparation before assignments for all lectors – varies by individual and by difficulty of readings.

What's Different for High School Lectors:

- ❖ Preparation (including orientation) is individualized, with an assigned lector mentor.
- ❖ Individual mentoring sessions prior to each lector assignment, with times that fit your personal schedule. (Less mentoring may be needed as you gain experience.)
