



## Returning to Sunday Mass at St. Francis Borgia



### Arrival:

- The plaza doors and the south west doors (from the Hwy NN parking lot) will be open 30 minutes prior to each Mass. The north entry doors cannot be used.
- Try to arrive 15 minutes prior to the start of Mass to assist in seating everyone.
- Please sanitize your hands upon entering the church. There are sanitizing stations at all of the doors. You may also bring personal sanitizer for use at other times.
- Ushers will provide worship aids for participation in Mass. Hymnals and Sunday Missals cannot be made available at this time.
- All holy water fonts are currently empty.
- As per the Governor's order, please wear a face covering.
- Please refrain from having conversations on your way into the church. This impedes the traffic flow and compromises distancing.

### Seating:

- Ushers will assist with seating and help to ensure safe distancing.
- Seating begins in the church space. When it is full, you will be seated in the hall. Should all seats be filled, ushers will provide you with other options.
- Household members may sit together; others must space 6-feet apart. Signs have been placed in the pews to provide a visual for distancing.

### Communion:

Communion will only be distributed under one form.

### Communion for those seated in the church space:

- You are invited to remain kneeling in your pew during Communion. The priest, deacon or Eucharistic Minister will come to you and distribute communion to you while you are kneeling.
- If you are not prepared to receive communion, simply cross your arms over your chest and the minister will pass you by.

### Communion for those in the hall:

- You are asked to remain in your seats. The priest, a deacon or a Eucharistic Minister will bring Communion downstairs to you.

### Departure:

- Whether you are seated in the church or in the hall, ushers will dismiss you after Mass to ensure safe distancing. Please follow their directions. We also ask that you observe silence and prayer until you are dismissed.
- Please don't linger or greet others while inside the building space.
- Once outside, you are welcome to stay and visit with others, but please move those conversations to areas that don't impede traffic flow from the church. Please remember to observe social distancing of 6-feet.
